Founded in 1838 and now a National Historic Landmark and accredited arboretum, Green-Wood was one of the first rural cemeteries in America. The Cemetery's 478 acres of rolling hills and glacial ponds are home to over 7,000 trees, boasting one of the largest collections of mature trees in the city. The Green-Wood Historic Fund was created in 1999 as a registered 501(c)(3) not-for-profit membership organization that works to maintain the Cemetery's monuments and buildings of historical, cultural, and architectural significance; to advance public knowledge and appreciation of the Cemetery; and to preserve the natural habitat of one of New York City's first green spaces.
