Founded in 1894, Third Street Music School Settlement is the nation's longest-running community music school. Celebrating 129 years of service, our fundamental belief is that arts education is a right, not a privilege. Over 75% of Third Street's students receive financial assistance or participate in tuition-free and highly-subsidized programs. The ISO at Third Street Symphonic Band was founded by its conductor Brian Worsdale in 1995 and has found its home at Third Street Music School Settlement since 2019.
